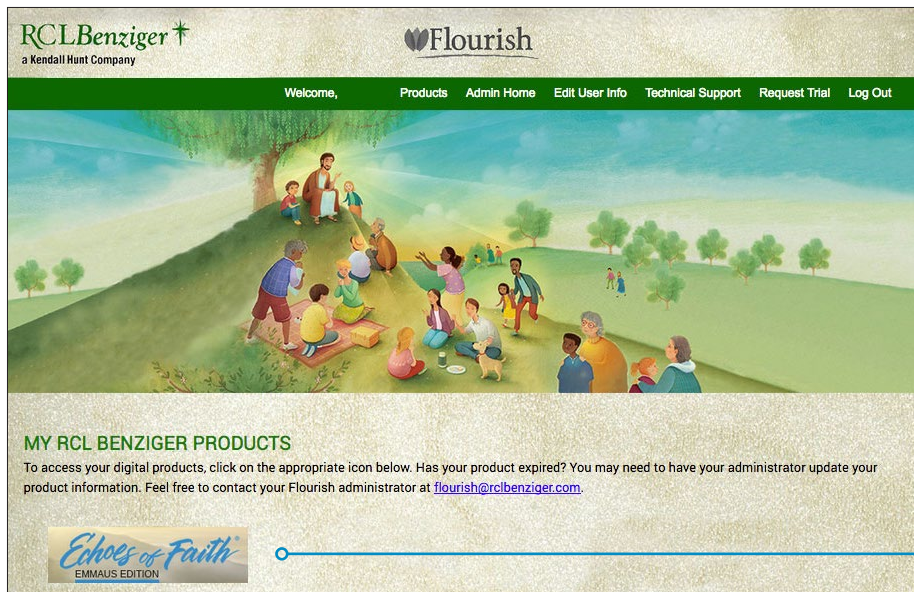

Ever since the creation of the world, [God's] invisible attributes of eternal power and divinity have been able to be understood and perceived in what he has made. Romans 1:20

There are different ways that we can come to know that God does exist and know about the nature of God. We can know certain things about God through our reason and discerning his divine work. For example, we can come to know about God through his work of Creation. Yet we can also come to know God through his Divine Revelation. Begin this first segment by completing the reflection questions.

### Segment Forecast

Catechist formation is a journey of faith. You might think of the *I Believe, We Believe* module as a pilgrimage that will take you to a series of holy places. The goal of **Segment 1: God the Father** is to help you reflect on the many ways that God reveals himself to us and to reflect on our responses that he calls us to make in faith.

**What I will learn...**  
In this segment, you will learn that:

- God is the **Creator** of all that exists. (CCC 279-301)
- Divine Revelation** is God's self-communication of everything he wants to know about himself. (CCC 50-65)
- Faith** is God's call to us, our loving response to him, and our adherence to what he has revealed. (CCC 142-144)
- The **Holy Trinity** is one God in three divine Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. (CCC 258-267)

\*CCC = Catechism of the Catholic Church

**Ways I will learn...**  
By the end of this segment, you will be able to:

- Compare the two Creation accounts in Genesis Chapter 1 and Chapter 2
- Define Divine Revelation and describe Jesus' role within it
- Express the nature and significance of faith
- Explain why the Church defined the dogma of the Holy Trinity

Each faith statement is followed by paragraph references to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC)*. If you click on the paragraph numbers, you can read more about these teachings of the Church. The *Catechism* is a good guidebook for your faith journey.

- Creeds are symbols of the faith that mark our identity as Christian identity and bind us together. (CCC 185-191)
- The Council of Nicaea in 325 A.D. and the Council of Constantinople in 381 A.D. clearly defined the Holy Trinity and settled the heresies surrounding it. (CCC 192-197, 465, 2089)
- The Communion of Saints refers to the faithful on earth, those gone before us who are still being purified, and the blessed who now live with God in Heaven. (CCC 946-959)
- The Marks of the Church are its four principal characteristics: one, holy, catholic, and apostolic. (CCC 813-865)
